The Old Yarmouth Pier

Constructed in the 1870s, Yarmouth's very own Victorian pleasure pier (the longest wooden pier in England) extends out of the town square and provides a gorgeous view of the port front – a great place to relax and enjoy an ice cream! The Roundhouse Museum is opening this summer; one to keep an eye out for!

Yarmouth Castle

Commissioned by King Henry VIII, Yarmouth Castle was initially one of his most sophisticated coastal fortresses. Now, it stands as an educational beacon with a fantastic picnic site on the roof to boot.

Yarmouth Town

Yarmouth is proud to offer an abundance of quirky shops and artisanal outlets including clothing, jewellers, galleries, a butcher and fishmonger in the town's delicatessen, eateries and an array of independent retailers dotted throughout the winding lanes.
